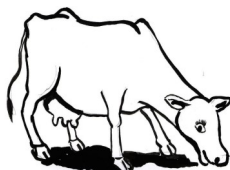
\*Welcome Spring!! I hope everyone is enjoying the sunny weather and moisture we have been receiving.
